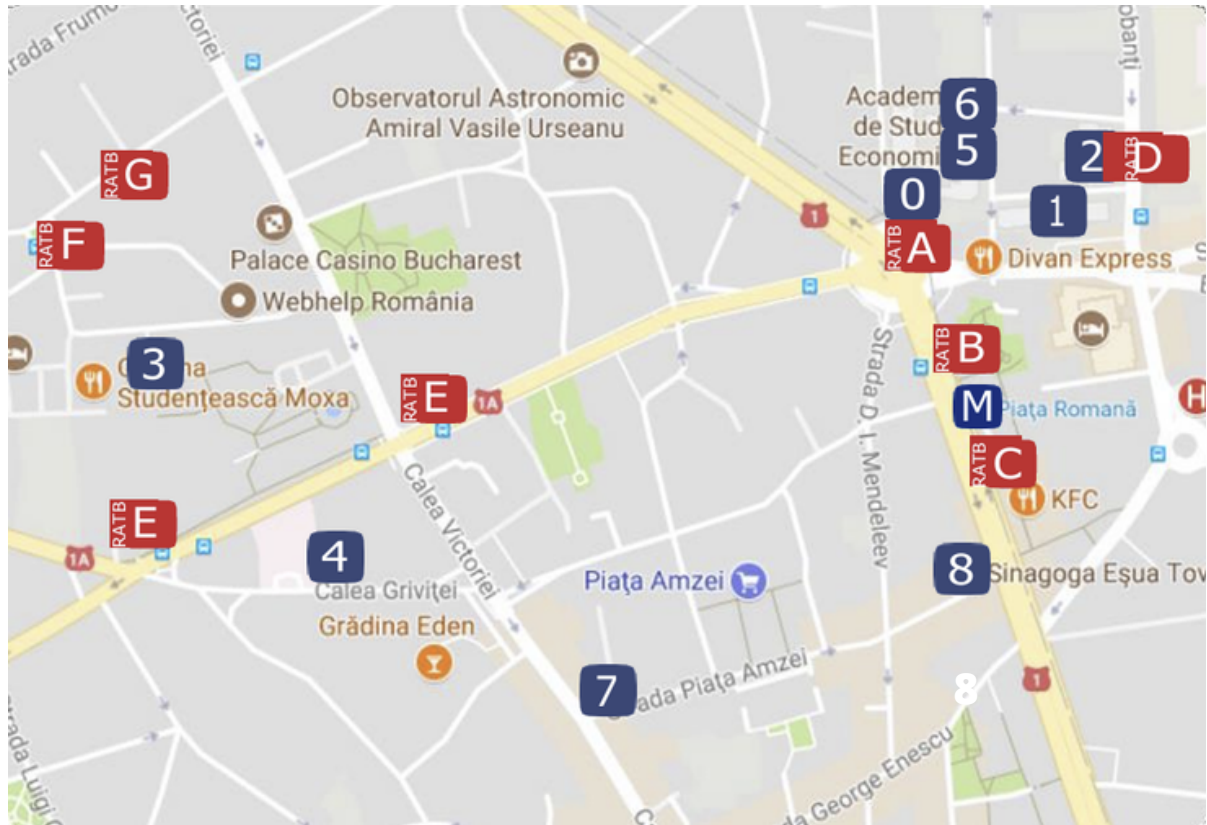

PERSONAL PAGE

As an ASE student, you have access to your personal page, which includes your personal data, school-related information, your electronic student card, and your electronic wallet (your account where you will find the fees you have paid).

Additionally, you have access to the platform called Online ASE, where you will find all the subjects you are studying, as well as the materials uploaded by the teaching staff.

The personal page allows you to view your schedule, exam dates, grades, and fees. It can be blocked if you do not pay the dormitory fee on time, if you are staying in one of the university's campuses. To unblock it, pay the outstanding fees and bring the receipt to the Social Department.

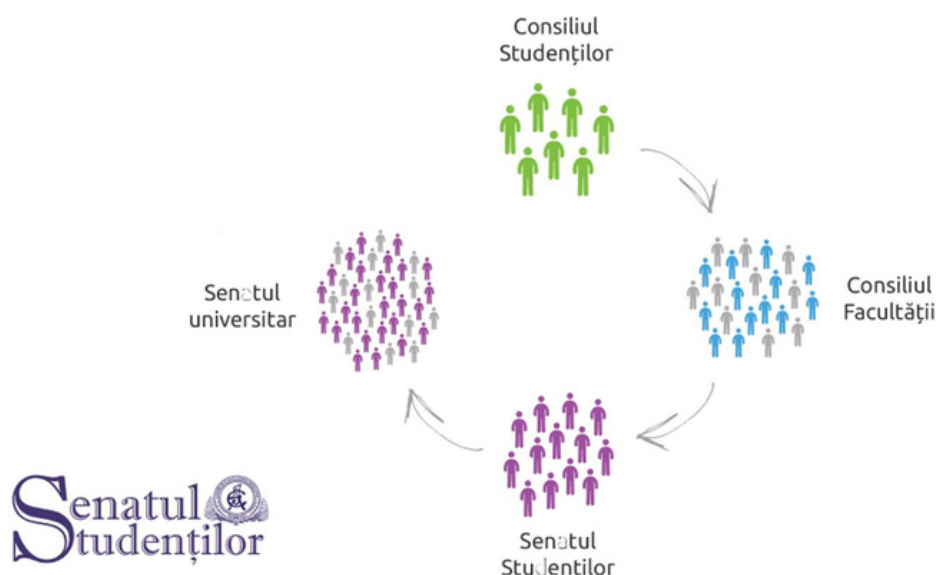

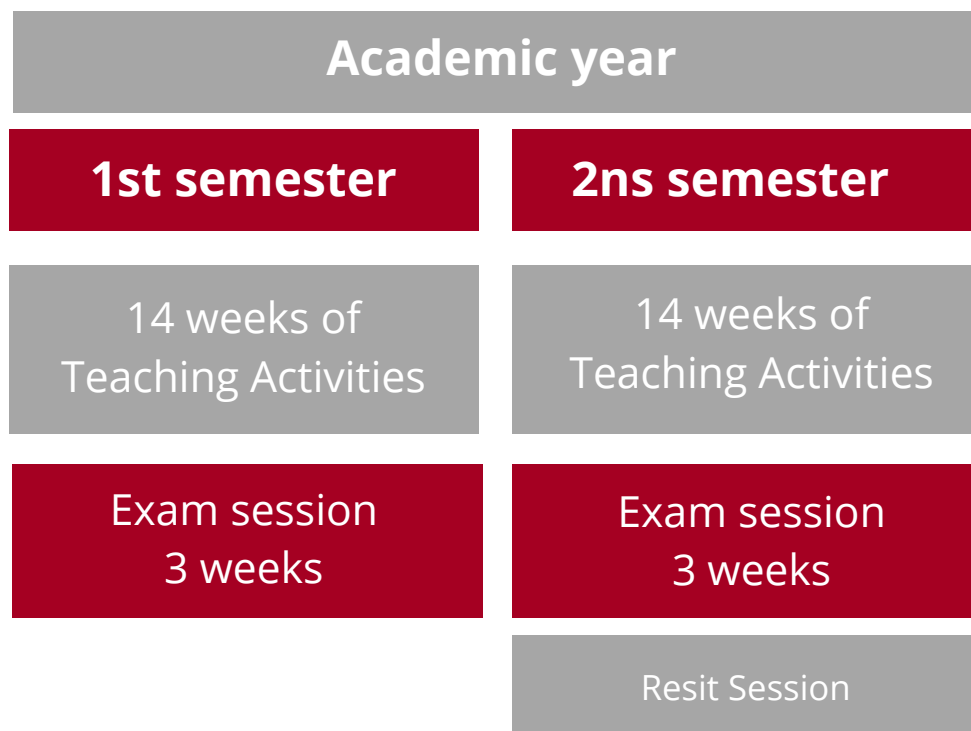
What is the Student Senate?

The Student Senate is the only student representation structure at the university level. It is part of the Union of Students of the Academy of Economic Studies in Bucharest (USASE), along with all other student representatives from each faculty and volunteer students.

To stay updated on regulations, calendars, events, and to find solutions for various issues you may encounter, students in the Senate are the first point of contact you should reach out to.

BACHELOR'S ACTIVITIES SCHEDULE 2026-2027

From the first year, you can advance to the second year if you have accumulated 30 credit points. From the second year, you can advance to the third year if you have accumulated 75 credit points.

Attention! Credit points for Physical Education and Sports are not counted.

The credit points (ECTS) associated with each study subject reflect the amount of work, expressed in hours, required for a student to achieve a coherent set of learning outcomes. This includes both organized activities (lectures, seminars, laboratory practicals, projects, internships, and participation in the evaluation process) and individual work (such as studying the taught material, completing assignments, and preparing papers and projects).

1 ECTS = 25 hours. For example, if a Public Finance course has 5 ECTS, you would need to allocate 125 hours to pass this subject.

The allocation of budget-funded places in the first year is done after the first semester and subsequently on an annual basis.

For students enrolled on a fee-paying basis, the annual tuition fee is divided into two installments. Each installment should be paid within the first three weeks of each semester (we recommend using <https://platonline.ase.ro>). First-year students have already paid the fee for the first semester upon confirming their admission place.

SCHEDULE AND COURSES

About the Schedule: As a student, you will have lectures (attended by all groups in your series) and seminars (held only with your specific group).

You can consult the schedule on your personal page (webstudent.ase.ro) and on the faculty's website.

Important to Know:

- Attendance at seminars is mandatory, and the evaluation result contributes 30-50% to the final grade, according to the course syllabus.

As a student, you have the opportunity to study three categories of courses: mandatory, optional, and elective.

- **Mandatory Courses:** These are part of your core curriculum and must be completed;
- **Optional Courses:** The faculty offers a range of optional courses through the curriculum, from which you can choose those you find important for your professional development. Completing a certain number of optional courses is mandatory. Once chosen, these optional courses become obligatory.
- **Additional Courses:** These are courses you can choose to take but are not required. Elective courses offered by FABBV will help you develop skills, such as communication in German.
- **Special Course:** Physical Education and Sports. Failing to pass this course by the third year will prevent you from completing your studies, even if you have accumulated the required 180 ECTS credits.



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

If you are among the top students in FABBV, you will be rewarded for your efforts with a scholarship provided by the Academy of Economic Studies in Bucharest.

Attention! All types of scholarships are awarded only to full-time students funded by the state budget.

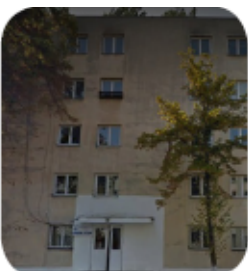

ASE LIBRARY

The library, with 725 reading seats across its central unit, branches, campus, and departmental branches, provides students with access to monographic publications, periodicals, electronic resources, e-books, and specialized scientific databases that support study and research interests as well as course syllabi. Access is granted with a free student ID card issued by ASE, which is valid throughout the study program and required for reading room services, book loans, extension of return deadlines, bibliographic reference services, database access, and additional support.



Database Access

The ASE Library provides access to a range of scientific databases, including full-text or abstract journals, e-book collections, and statistical data platforms. Key resources include JSTOR Business Collection I & II: Periodicals, ProQuest Ebrary: E-books, ScienceDirect: E-books, Emerald: E-books, SpringerLink: E-books, Thomson Reuters Eikon and Bloomberg: Statistical data

Through the Anelis Plus 2020 project, library users also have access to ScienceDirect Freedom Collection, ProQuest Central, Emerald, Thomson ISI, Scopus

PSYCHOPEDAGOGICAL TRAINING

Do you want to become a professor?

The Academy of Economic Studies can assist you through the Department for the Preparation of Teaching Staff (DPPD), which aims to provide pedagogical, psychological, and methodological training to students and graduates who choose a teaching career.

The psychopedagogical training program is a distinct set of elective courses separate from your specialized study program. Completing this program will grant you an additional qualification as a teacher. If you have enrolled, make sure to follow the schedule of teaching activities and attend the courses.

Educational Offerings of the Department for the Preparation of Teaching Staff:

- **Undergraduate Cycle** - Level I (Initial): Grants graduates of bachelor's degrees the right to hold teaching positions in pre-school, primary, and secondary education.
- **Master's Cycle** - Level II (Advanced): Grants graduates of bachelor's degrees the right to hold teaching positions at all levels of pre-university and higher education.

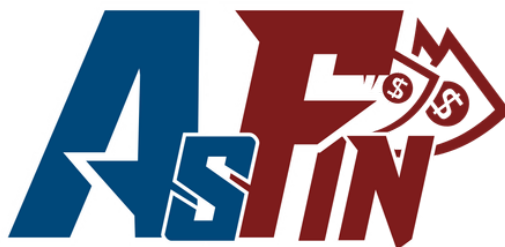


ASFIN - Finance Students' Association
